


- b. Permit to Transport issued to Security Agencies shall likewise have a duration of seven (7) days or one (1) week which shall cover the period from receipt of the security agency's Main Office to the posting/distribution of the firearms/ammunition to the agency's respective employee/end-user and vice versa as the case maybe. Likewise, this PTT shall only be valid when the COMELEC Gun Ban Committee officially receives the same and a copy is submitted to the FED. (NOTE: The following documents are required for the PTT approval: (1) Certificate of Authority issued by the COMELEC CBFSP or while the same is on process, a received copy of the application for Certificate of Authority will suffice; (2) Photocopy of the PSA's current License to Operate (LTO); and (3) PTT stating the posting and transport of FAs from point of origin to the destination duly signed by the C, FED or his authorized representative);
- c. Permit to Transport issued to individuals for newly-purchased firearms/ammunition shall have a validity of 24 hours within which period the gun-owner shall have transported his newly-acquired firearm from the dealer to his residence. (NOTE: The following documents are required for the PTT approval: (1) Temporary license issued to the buyer duly approved by C, FED; (2) PTT covering the purchased FA issued in the name of the owner/representative duly signed by the C, FED or his authorized representative and stamped "received" by the CBFSP); and
- d. Permit to Transport issued to Gun Club Members who are affiliated to the Philippine Practical Shooting Association and the Philippine National Shooting Association for the purpose of shooting competition in preparation for international shooting events shall be endorsed by their respective associations to the Firearms and Explosives Division and the COMELEC CBFSP. This PTT shall only be valid when the COMELEC CBFSP officially receives the same and a copy is submitted to the FED. (NOTE: The duration of the PTT to be granted to Gun Club members shall depend on the competition and practice schedules submitted by the PPSA and PNSA and shall prescribe specific dates of the same. The following documents are required for the PTT approval: (1) Indorsement letter addressed to FED and COMELEC CBFSP from the PPSA/PNSA endorsing the applicant Gun Club and its members; (2) Official list of Gun Club members and their corresponding list of FA to be used during the competition/practice duly signed by the Gun Club President; (3) Photocopy of the current Gun Club Accreditation of the concerned Gun Clubs).

IV. RESCISSION CLAUSE

The above regulations shall be strictly enforced, the violations of which shall make the individual/party involved liable to applicable sanctions under the law.
