

PERMISSION TO CONDUCT HIGH POWER RIFLE MATCHES

THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE, THRU PNP CIRCULAR NO. 14, DATED 25 MARCH 2008 HAS GRANTED THE PHILIPPINE PRACTICAL SHOOTING ASSOCIATION PERMISSION TO CONDUCT AND SANCTION HIGH POWER RIFLE MATCHES.

THE CIRCULAR APPLIES TO ALL LEGITIMATE HIGH POWER RIFLE HOLDERS WHO INTEND TO USE THEIR LICENSED RIFLES IN SANCTIONED MATCHES IN SHOOTING RANGES DULY ACCREDITED BY THE FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES DIVISION OF THE CIVIL SECURITY GROUP, PNP.

ISSUANCE OF TRANSPORT PERMITS

ONLY CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE PHILIPPINE PRACTICAL SHOOTING ASSOCIATION SHALL BE ISSUED PERMITS TO TRANSPORT (PTT). PTT'S FOR RIFLE COMPETITIONS SHALL BE ISSUED BASED ON THE MATCH SCHEDULE CALENDARED BY THE PPSA.

MEMBERS WHO HAVE BEEN ISSUED PTT'S ARE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MATCH INDICATED IN THE PERMIT. MEMBERS WHO DO NOT COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE MAY BE DENIED FURTHER ISSUANCE OF PTT'S.

MATCH SANCTIONING

ALL IPSC RIFLE MATCHES MUST HAVE PRIOR SANCTIONING FROM THE PPSA RIFLE COMMITTEE, PPSA PRESIDENT AND THE REGIONAL DIRECTOR AND SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE LATEST IPSC RULES AND ONLY MATCH OFFICIALS WHO ARE ACTIVE MEMBERS OF THE NROI ARE ALLOWED TO OFFICIATE AT A MATCH.

MATCH HOSTING AND PARTICIPATION

MATCH SANCTIONING FEES ARE WAIVED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

ONLY PPSA MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING MAY JOIN IPSC RIFLE MATCHES

ORGANIC PNP/AFP/NALECC OFFICERS AND PERSONEL NEED NOT BE MEMBERS OF PPSA TO PARTICIPATE IN IPSC RIFLE MATCHES

MATCHES SHALL ONLY BE HELD IN FED APPROVED FIRING RANGES

PERMITS TO TRANSPORT AND PPSA MEMBERSHIP ID'S SHALL BE REQUIRED AT ALL MATCHES

ANY PPSA MEMBER GUN CLUB IN GOOD STANDING MAY HOST A RIFLE MATCH PROVIDED THAT THE MATCH IS HELD IN A DULY ACCREDITED RIFLE RANGE

ANY PNP/AFP ENTITY THAT WISHES TO HOST AN IPSC RIFLE MATCH AT A MILITARY RANGE SHALL BE ACCOMODATED ON A CASE-TO-CASE BASIS (PPSA MEMBER PARTICIPATION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE FED)

EQUIPMENT

RIFLES MUST BE FITTED WITH A STOCK FOR IT TO BE FIRED FROM THE SHOULDER

MINIMUM BARREL LENGTH OF RIFLES SHALL BE 14.5 INCHES (WHICH MAY INCLUDE A FLASH HIDER, MUZZLE BRAKE OR COMPENSATOR)

MAXIMUM CALIBER IS 7.62MM

RIFLES OFFERING ONLY BURST AND/OR FULLY AUTOMATIC FIRE ARE PROHIBITED

SPARE MAGAZINES MAY BE CARRIED IN APPROPRIATE RETENTION DEVICES EITHER ON THE RIFLE OR ON THE SHOOTER, THERE IS NO LIMIT IN MAGAZINE SIZE AND MAGAZINE CAPACITY (UNLESS SPECIFIED IN THE DIVISION OR COURSE OF FIRE)

THE USE OF BIPODS ARE ALLOWED IN OPEN DIVISION ONLY

RIFLES MUST BE KEPT IN A CASE OR BAG AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN ON THE FIRING LINE (SHOOTERS WHO ARE ON-DECK MAY PLACE RIFLES AT DESIGNATED RIFLE RACKS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE STAGE RO)

THE USE OF "HOUSE GUNS" SHALL BE ALLOWED WHEN AVAILABLE

COURSES OF FIRE / TARGETS / DISTANCES

RECOMMENDED TARGET DISTANCES ARE 30% LESS THAN 60 METERS, 50% BETWEEN 60 AND 150 METERS AND 20% BETWEEN 150 AND 300 METERS

METAL TARGETS MUST BE AT A DISTANCE OF LEAST 50 METERS WHEN A PHYSICAL BARRIER IS PRESENT AND 55 METERS WHEN A CHARGE LINE IS USED

DIMENSIONS OF A RECTANGULAR PLATE SHALL BE 30CM X 45CM (MAX) AND 15CM X 15CM (MIN) AND DIAMETER OF A ROUND PLATE SHALL BE 30CM (MAX) AND 15CM (MIN).

FRANGIBLE TARGETS SUCH AS CLAY TARGETS AND TILES MAY BE USED

RANGE ATTIRE

WEARING MILITARY / PARA MILITARY ATTIRE IS PROHIBITED UNLESS THE PARTICIPANT IS AN ORGANIC MEMBER OF THE PNP/ AFP WEARING THE OFFICIAL UNIFORM OF HIS/HER UNIT

ATTIRE BEARING OFFENSIVE AND/OR CONTROVERTIAL SLOGANS, SYMBOLS AND GRAPHICS ARE SPECIFICALLY PROHIBITED
