



MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR 1-2018

TO : Members of the Board of Directors, PPSA Area Coordinators, NROI Area Coordinators, Gun Club Presidents, and PPSA Members

SUBJECT : Guidelines for the Selection of Philippine Team Members vying for spots in Australasia Philippines 2019 and World Shoot XIX 2020 in Thailand

I. OBJECTIVE

The objective is to develop the skills of shooters nationwide through participation in Level 3 or higher matches with courses of fire designed and constructed to test shooters skills in a competitive environment ensuring a World Class Standing and podium finish.

To qualify, aspirants will need to meet percentile requirements that will be based on the results of the Qualifier card matches.

II. ASPIRANTS QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

A. FOR AUSTRALASIA 2019*

DIVISIONS = BEST 5 PERCENTILE SCORES TO COUNT
CATEGORIES = BEST 3 PERCENTILE SCORES TO COUNT

B. FOR WORLD SHOOT XIX

DIVISIONS** = BEST 10 PERCENTILE SCORES TO COUNT
CATEGORIES+ = BEST 6 PERCENTILE SCORES TO COUNT

*LAST AA QUALIFIER MATCH WILL BE ANNOUNCED BY THE PPSA.

**TO QUALIFY FOR WORLD SHOOT XIX DIVISION SLOTS/TEAMS,ASPIRANTS MUST SHOOT AUSTRALASIA 2019 AND AT LEAST 1 QUALIFIER MATCH IN 2020.

THE ASPIRANTS AUSTRALASIA SCORES WILL COUNT TWICE FOR SCORE. (THE PPSA MAY SEGREGATE THE PHILIPPINE REGION'S AUSTRALASIA SCORES FOR QUALIFIER TABULATION PURPOSES).

+WORLD SHOOT XIX CATEGORY ASPIRANTS MUST SHOOT AT LEAST ONE (1) QUALIFIER MATCH IN 2020.

III. TENTATIVE / PROPOSED MATCHES

All Qualifier Matches will be posted on the PPSA Official Social Network Page, PPSA/PSMOC Shooters Page, and PPSA Official website. In the event that there is a shortage of Qualifier Matches, *the Match Committee may declare other Level III matches as Wild Card Matches which will be declared via transparent raffle.*

IV. TEAM SELECTION BASIS

A. AA2019 Division Teams and Slot Allocation

For Division Teams, the total of the **best (5) match scores (percentile)** of each aspirant in the **2018/2019 Qualifier Matches** will be the basis for Division Team selection.

For Categories, the total of the **best (3) match scores (percentile)** of each aspirant will be the basis for Category Slot Allocation for Teams and Individuals.

In case of a tie, the highest percentile out of the 5 match scores will be used as basis to break the tie. In case this will still result in a tie, the highest percentile of the remaining 4 Qualifier Matches will be used.

After every qualifier match, the ranking of each aspirant will be posted in the PPSA Official Social Network Page, PPSA/PSMOC Shooters Page, and PPSA Official website.

The PPSA reserves the right to lessen the number of match scores/percentiles to be counted in case some Qualifier Matches will be cancelled due to non compliance of the criteria/requirements/Terms and Conditions set forth by the Match Committee or due to weather, peace and order, political, regulatory, or other major issues beyond the control of PPSA.



B. WORLD SHOOT XIX Division Teams and Slot Allocation

For Division Teams, the total of the **best (10) match scores (percentile)** of each aspirant in the **2018-2020 Qualifier Matches** will be the basis for Division Team selection.

For Categories, the total of the **best (6) match scores (percentile)** of each aspirant will be the basis for Category Slot Allocation for Teams and Individuals.

In case of a tie, the highest percentile out of the 10 will be used as basis to break the tie. In case this will still result in a tie, the highest percentile out of the remaining 9 Qualifier Matches will be used.

After every qualifier match, the ranking of each aspirant will be posted in the PPSA Official Social Network Page, PPSA/PSMOC Shooters Page, and PPSA Official website.

The PPSA reserves the right to lessen the number of match scores/percentiles to be counted in case some Qualifier Matches will be cancelled due to non compliance of the criteria/requirements/Terms and Conditions set forth by the Match Committee or due to weather, peace and order, political, regulatory, or other major issues beyond the control of PPSA.

D. WORLD SHOOT XIX Categories

We have been informed by IPSC that slots for WORLD SHOOT XIX will be very limited. The actual number of slots may vary depending upon the actual number of slots to be given by IPSC.

To qualify for the slot, **WORLD SHOOT XIX Category Shooters** should have the following average percentiles in six (6) Qualifier/Wild Card Matches up to the last match in 2020.

PPSA will sponsor the Category registration fee if the aspirant's qualifier average reaches the minimum percentile (%) stipulated in this memorandum for AA2019 and WORLD SHOOT XIX, **AGAIN SUBJECT TO SLOT AVAILABILITY.**

V. DURATION OF QUALIFIER MATCHES & SANCTIONING POLICIES

All Australasia 2019 and World Shoot XIX Qualifier matches will be announced and posted in the PPSA Official Social Network Page, PPSA/PSMOC Shooters Page, and PPSA Official website.

All other Level III matches may be declared as Wild Card matches in the event that there is a shortage of qualifier matches.


VI. ASPIRANTS SHOULD SIGNIFY THEIR INTENT

Aspirants will need to fill up an application form and affix their signature as a sign of agreement & conformity with the terms and conditions and send the signed form to the PPSA office or through email at a.ppsa@yahoo.com.ph so that their scores will be monitored.

ONLY MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING MAY QUALIFY.

The form will be available for download from the PPSA website.

It is important for all aspirants to contact the PPSA Office before booking their flights so that they will be squadded together with shooters of the same Division and Category



Scores will not be counted in the computation of the ranking of shooters if aspirants will not shoot in their designated squads.

Filled up and signed forms should be submitted by July 31, 2018.

In the event the aspirant decides to qualify in another Division/Category, he/she must inform the PPSA in writing 30 days before the next qualifier match. His/her request will be subject to PPSA approval.

Given names as indicated in their passports should be used in the match registration forms.

VII. SHIPMENT OF FIREARMS & AMMO

All Philippine delegates are responsible for bringing their own firearms and ammunition to World Shoot XIX.

The PPSA will furnish all information and documents needed.

Delegates may also consider using the Official Match Ammo.

VIII. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS & CONDITIONS

Aspirants/Team members should possess travel documents as required by law.

Team members are required to attend the Opening Ceremony (Parade) and Awarding Ceremony of WORLD SHOOT XIX wearing the prescribed uniform or attire.

For fully sponsored delegates, PPSA will procure plane tickets and book hotel accommodations based on the best prices available. Any upgrade/alterations shall be for the account of the delegate. There will be no reimbursements should the sponsored delegate purchase his/her own plane ticket and/or hotel accommodations.

All aspirants should shoot in the main match of Qualifier Matches. Scores in the Pre-match will not be accepted and will not be included in the computation of the rankings.


At Level III Qualifier matches where more than one discipline is offered the aspirant must shoot the Handgun Discipline first before attempting to shoot the Mini Rifle discipline. This infraction will result in automatic deletion of his Handgun scores for that match.



IX. EFFECTIVITY
